## DIRECTIONS

The Earl V. Moore School of Music, Theatre & Dance Building is located on North Campus at 1100 Baits Drive. The directions below will provide some general help in guiding you to Ann Arbor.

- **U.S. 23** - If you are staying on **North Campus** or going directly to the **School of Music, Theatre & Dance**, take the Plymouth Road exit. If you are traveling South on U.S. 23 turn right onto Plymouth Road, or from North U.S. 23 turn left onto Plymouth Road. Follow Plymouth Road until you get to Murfin (about 1.5 miles). Turn left onto Murfin, and you will come to a four-way stop at Hubbard Road. Go straight (past the dormitory) and take a right at Duffield, the next street. Duffield ends at Baits Drive. Take a left on Baits, which will end at the School of Music, Theatre & Dance parking lot.

To get to **Central Campus** from U.S. 23, take the Washtenaw Avenue-Ann Arbor exit. Go through the intersection with Huron Parkway and pass the Whole Foods shopping plaza on the right. Washtenaw splits about two miles after the U.S. 23 exit, so be sure to take the right fork and follow Washtenaw into the Central Campus area.

- **I-94** - To get to **North Campus** or the **School of Music, Theatre & Dance**, take the exit for U.S. 23 North and follow the above directions. If you are staying on **Central Campus**, exit off I-94 on S. State Street and follow it north into downtown Ann Arbor.

## PARKING

On our published audition days an on-site parking attendant will issue parking permits for a nominal fee. If you are visiting on other days, limited metered parking is available in the Moore Building lot. There is some parking adjacent to the Walgreen Drama Center, but it is a short walk from the Moore Building lot to the Walgreen. At the Moore Building lot, visitor parking is located at the south end and is indicated with red and white numbered signs. The central meter for the lot accepts bills, coins, and credit card (Visa/MC/Discover); metered parking is in effect from 6AM-5PM, Monday-Friday. **DO NOT** park in the areas marked **Blue Parking**. These areas are strictly patrolled by the University police, and you **will** be ticketed.

## A WORD OF CAUTION

Ann Arbor driving often involves some tricky navigation. Please allow yourself enough time to find everything, and don't be afraid to ask for directions. If all else fails, give us a call and we will help you find your way.

## TRAVEL INFORMATION

### FLIGHTS AND AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION

Students traveling by air usually book flights into **Detroit Metropolitan Airport (DTW)**. Once at Metro, it is relatively easy to get to Ann Arbor. Taxi cab fare is approximately **\$60**. There are also various airport shuttle and limousine companies with which you can reserve a seat. Prices vary from **\$28-40** per person each way (updated prices August 2008). **Amtrak** serves Ann Arbor with connections from Toledo and Chicago. For fare and schedule information, call 800/872-7245.

If you are traveling either by bus or by train, be aware that those schedules tend to run behind, especially in the winter. Please leave yourself plenty of time to get oriented with the city and campus.

### LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IN ANN ARBOR

**Bus Service** The University of Michigan has a free bus system which serves both the Central and North Campus areas. The bus stops are clearly marked. The **BURSLEY-BAITS, COMMUTER (NORTHBOUND)** or **NORTHWOOD** buses will bring you to the School of Music, Theatre & Dance from the bus stop in front of the **C.C. Little Building**. You may also catch the **COMMUTER** bus in front of the **Michigan Union**. On average, these lines run every 10-15 minutes, and the ride between Central and North Campus usually takes about ten minutes.
