Bursley Hall check-in/check-out and Final Presentations on North Campus

Check-in: 12:30 PM on the first Sunday of the session

Check-out: 9:00 AM on the final Saturday of the session

You may temporarily stop in the Bursley Hall front circle (1931 Duffield Street) to unload/load luggage at Bursley. Do not park in spaces marked for fire lanes, business vehicles, or commercial plate vehicles. Read signs carefully so you are not ticketed.

Once you have unloaded/loaded luggage, proceed to the School of Music Moore Building parking lot (NC10) where parking is free on weekends. Parking here will allow for a short walk to Bursley Hall, the School of Music Moore Building, and the Walgreen Drama Center. *Note: On July 12, a parking attendant may be selling \$5 permits to park in the Walgreen Drama Center lot. You may choose this option or park for free in the Moore Building lot.*

Section B:

Summer Dance Institute check-in/check-out and Final Presentation on Central Campus

Check-in: 3:00 PM on Sunday, July 13

Check-out: Immediately following the 10:30 AM presentation on Saturday, July 26

The parking lot behind Markley Hall (1503 Washington Heights) does not require parking permits on Saturdays or Sundays so you may park in most spaces (not Gold Permit spaces or others requiring permits 24/7). On-street metered parking is also available. When driving, enter at the corner of Observatory Street and Washington Heights. On that corner there is a sign for a one-way street (Washington Heights) and the Vaughan School of Public Health. The main entrance to Markley Hall is from this parking lot on Washington Heights. The Dance Building is a short walk from Markley Hall.

Section C:

Musical Theatre Workshop

For check-in and check-out information see Section A above for Bursley Hall.

Check-in: 12:30 PM on Sunday, July 6

Check-out: 9:00 AM on Saturday, July 26

The final presentation on Saturday, July 26 is at the Mendelssohn Theatre (911 N University Ave) on Central Campus. Once parents have checked their children out of Bursley Hall at 9:00 AM on Saturday, July 26 (and loaded their luggage into a vehicle), parents are free to explore Ann Arbor until the 1:00 PM presentation. Following check-out, students will have class and lunch and then will take busses to the Mendelssohn Theatre.

Parking options near the Mendelssohn Theatre (which is in the Michigan League building) include on-street metered parking as well as a visitor section of the Palmer Drive parking structure. To park in the visitor section of the Palmer Structure, enter at the stoplight of Palmer Drive and Washtenaw Avenue (near Palmer Commons and the Life Sciences Institute). The visitor rate is approximately \$1.10/hr.
